

Live-remote Training courses offered in Colorado

Training Provider requirements:

- 1. Colorado-approved training provider only.
- 2. Establish which platform that will be utilized (ensuring security).
- 3. Courses must be password-protected.
- 4. Ability to remove participant from class.
- 5. Remote learning class cannot be combined with in-person class.
- 6. Prepare course materials to be utilized on digital platform, if necessary.
- 7. REFRESHER COURSES ONLY!!!!
- 8. Live classes only, offered M-F (Sa), 8A-5P.
- 9. Course taught only by Division-approved instructor(s).
- 10. Course must be offered from professional environment (office, home-based office, etc.) utilizing a dual-monitor computer (laptop or desktop) equipped with speakers and microphone.
- 11. Class size limited to 12 maximum.
- 12. 10-day notification to Division.
- 13. Pre-register all course participants.
- 14. Require participant to have stationary computer equipped with monitor, speakers and microphone.
- 15. Verify participants' identity US Government issued (driver's license, state-issued ID card, US passport, immigration car, etc.).
- 16. Verify current AHERA training(s).
- 17. Send course invite & password to participants and division.
- 18. Email or mail course materials (Syllabus, handouts, regulations, etc.) to participants and Division.
- 19. Upon completion of course:
 - a. Email student a copy of course certificate(s) and mail original to address listed on registration
 - b. Certificates labeled "Colorado-approved Live-Remote course"
 - c. Email course certificates for entire class to Division
 - d. Email Division course confirmation list at conclusion of class
- 20. Submit \$10/per student fee within 30 days of the course completion

Class Participant requirements:

- 1. Must pre-register for live-remote learning refresher class.
- 2. Must have verifiable current training certificates and produce them upon request.
- 3. Each student must have their own stationary computer equipped with monitor, speakers and microphone (NO CELL PHONES or TABLETS).
- 4. Participant must be located in a course-conducive environment.
- 5. Participant must not leave the presence of the monitor/camera without instructor approval.
- 6. Participant must keep mic/camera active at all times during class.
